Authors should submit their paper **electronically** to [lj@iucr.org](mailto:lj@iucr.org) or [ccp4conf@dl.ac.uk](mailto:ccp4conf@dl.ac.uk). Papers are expected to be submitted by the end of the meeting on **4 January 2003**.

**2. Manuscript preparation****2.1. File formats**

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Figures should be sent in PostScript, encapsulated PostScript or TIFF formats. The resolution of bitmap graphics should be a minimum of 1200 d.p.i.

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All contributions must be preceded by an *Abstract* in English. The *Abstract* should be no more than 200 words and it should make no reference to tables, diagrams or formulae contained in the body of the paper. Literature references in the *Abstract* are discouraged but if a reference is unavoidable it should be sufficiently full within the *Abstract* for unambiguous identification, e.g. [Jones (2001). *Acta Cryst.* **D57**, 1–10].

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The International System of Units (SI) is used except that the ångström (symbol Å, defined as 10<sup>-10</sup> m) is generally preferred to the nanometre (nm) or picometre (pm) as the appropriate unit of length. Recommended prefixes of decimal multiples should be used rather than '× 10<sup>n</sup>'.

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Figures should be prepared using one of the file formats listed in §2.1. Diagrams may also be required in 'hard-copy' form.
