

**Expression, purification, crystallization
and preliminary X-ray studies of
Lactobacillus jensenii enolase.
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The article by Harris *et al.* [(2010) *Acta Cryst.* **F66**, 938–940] is corrected.

Sequencing of the 16S rDNA from the *Lactobacillus* strain used as the source of the enolase gene used for the studies reported in the article by Harris *et al.* (2010) has shown that what was reported as *Lactobacillus jensenii* 25258 is in fact *Lactobacillus gasserii* 33323. Further studies of this crystallized enolase will properly attribute the enzyme to *L. gasserii*. We sincerely apologize for any confusion arising from this unfortunate error.
