# Technical Editors

11 full-time-equivalent editorial staff work on eight journals and International Tables

Each journal has a Technical Editor in charge

All Technical Editors are trained in all aspects of technical editing and can work on other journals/books as necessary

Technical Editors duties include checking submissions when they arrive, helping authors and editors if problems arise, editing papers when they are accepted, typesetting and proofreading papers, organising papers into issues, putting articles online, sending data to external bodies and presenting talks at meetings(!)
